You are eligible to enroll at Claremont School of Theology as a transient student if you:

- 1. are currently a graduate degree-seeking student at another regionally accredited college or university,
2. are in good academic standing at your home institution and are eligible to return for further study,
3. have obtained your home institution's permission on this form,
4. have successfully completed any applicable prerequisites for the course(s) in which you plan to enroll and,
5. have not been expelled or suspended from CST.

Transient students are subject to the same rules, regulations, practices, and policies of the School as are degree candidates. Transient student status terminates at the end of the semester of enrollment. Subsequent enrollment as a transient student requires submission of a new form. No more than 12 semester hours of credit can be earned in transient status. If a transient student wishes, at a later date, to enroll in a degree program at Claremont School of Theology, he or she must make a formal application, pay the prevailing application fee and fulfill all graduate admission requirements. Acceptance as a transient student in no way obligates Claremont School of Theology to accept such a student at a later time as a degree candidate. Transient students are not eligible for financial aid.
