



## Statutes of Limitation for On-Campus Housing Acknowledgement

**Qualifications**—The following qualifications, rules, and regulations apply to residents in all on-campus housing:

- Students who have officially accepted admission into Claremont School of Theology (CST)
- Students who have paid their Confirmation Fee
- Students who have filed a Housing Reservation form and paid the Housing Application Fee
- Students who are full-time, degree –seeking students. A minimum of nine (9) credits per semester or maintenance and matriculation are required to classify a student as full-time for the academic year.

**Eligibility and Limitation**—Housing eligibility varies according to each degree program.

Degree Program	On-Campus Residency Limitation
MA	2 years
MDiv	3 years
PhD	4 years
DMin	2 years

Students who have reached the maximum years of housing limitation and would like to petition for additional time in on-campus housing in order to complete a degree program may complete an Application to Continue Living in On-Campus Housing after Eligibility has Expired form. The application must be submitted to the Housing Office no later than April 1<sup>st</sup> and does not guarantee extension/lease renewal.

Applicants will be notified by May 10<sup>th</sup> whether or not their application has been accepted. The lease term ends on May 31<sup>st</sup> of each year; therefore, move out will need to be scheduled on or before May 31<sup>st</sup> if the application is not accepted.
