



Application to Continue Living in On-Campus Housing after Eligibility has Expired

Students who have reached the statute of limitation for on-campus housing based on their degree program or who are no longer enrolled as full-time, degree-seeking students at Claremont School of Theology may apply for additional time in School housing. A minimum of nine (9) credits per semester or maintenance and matriculation are required to classify a student as full-time for the academic year.

Application does not guarantee lease renewal.

Applicants will be notified by May 10th whether or not their application has been accepted. The lease term ends on May 31st of each year; therefore, move out will need to be scheduled on or before May 31st if the application is not accepted.
